OVERVIEW

The 2020 Emerging Professionals Awards Program recognizes excellence in the architectural profession for emerging architects and is presented by the AIA Fort Lauderdale and AIA Miami Chapters of the American Institute of Architects. These Awards are intended to acknowledge the accomplishments and achievements of young architectural professionals, encourages a synergy of involvement and participation among that demographic, and promotes public consciousness of the built environment.

WHO CAN APPLY?

The submittals are open to architecture students, architectural design professionals, and architects licensed less than 10 years, and is open to both AIA/AIAS Members and Non-Members. Entries can be submitted by individuals or by firms who reside/work in the Miami-Dade and Broward Counties. Refer to individual awards for specific requirements.
